CITIZENS CAN EXERCISE THEIR CIVIC DUTY

VOTE YES OR NO----ON HOME TAX RELIEF

Towns County citizens can vote YES or NO to increase their \$2,000 Homestead Exemption by \$8,000 making a total of \$10,000 tax assessed or \$25,000 Fair Market Value of their home of which they would pay no taxes.

As your elected Commissioner, I requested this Legislation which was introduced by State Rep. Allison and Sen. Butterworth allowing Towns County Citizens a voice, through their vote, on how they wish to fund their governmental services. Towns County citizens can exercise their civic responsibility and privilege by voting YES or NO Nov. 3. If approved exemption will be effective Jan. 1, 2010.
